Location: The Cemetery is located 1.5 kilometres south-west of Valletta on the road to Sliema. On the edge of the Gwardamanga district, the entrance is on Triq Il-Principessa Melita, leading to Triq Tal-Pieta and Msida Sea Front and Creek.

Historical Information: Pieta was the principal garrison cemetery and is laid out in rectangular paved terraces. There are now over 1,000, 1914-18 and nearly 200, 1939-45 war casualties commemorated in this site. Of the 1914-1918 graves, five were brought after the Armistice from Lazaretto Cemetery, two from outside Addolorata Cemetery and one from Gozo Cemetery. There is also a tablet erected commemorating Indian servicemen whose bodies were cremated at Lazaretto Cemetery.
