Location:

Pommereuil is a village 3 kilometres east of Le Cateau. The British Cemetery is on the south side of the D959, Le Cateau to Landrecies.

Historical Information:

Pommereuil was the scene of severe fighting on the 23rd-24th October, 1918; and after the capture of the village the British Cemetery was made by the 25th Division. There are now nearly 200, 1914-18 war casualties commemorated in this site. The 20th Manchesters erected in the cemetery a wooden memorial to their officers and men who fell on the 23rd October. Seventy-five unknown German soldiers were buried in a plot adjoining the cemetery on the East. The cemetery covers an area of 948 square metres and is enclosed partly by a wall and partly by a concrete curb.
